*The way to receive salvation is simple because Jesus did all the work for us. All He requires is that we believe in Him and what He did. Romans 10:9-10 states "that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead you shall be saved. For with the heart man believes unto righteousness and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation." If you believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, that He died on the cross for you, bore your sins, and was raised from the dead then confess that with your mouth, you are saved. Remember it is not of works lest any man should boast. If someone asks you how do you know you're saved tell them because I believe in Jesus. You're not saved any other way but by faith in the Lord Jesus Christ alone.*
